

Select Medical Relocates Critical Illness Recovery Hospital on UF Health Campus

MECHANICSBURG, PENNSYLVANIA– JULY 30, 2018 – Select Medical today announced Select Specialty Hospital – Gainesville, a critical illness recovery hospital, has relocated to the recently renovated fifth floor of the University of Florida Health Shands Hospital. Select Specialty Hospital – Gainesville is a joint venture partnership between Select Medical and UF Health.

Select Medical will oversee operations of the 48-bed hospital that will provide specialized care to patients who require extended medical treatment and recovery time due to critical illness. Patients receive individualized treatment plans led by a physician and coordinated with multidisciplinary teams of nurses, therapists, specialists, pharmacists and aides.

“Our collaboration with UF Health is anchored by a shared commitment to deliver high quality care and clinical outcomes to Gainesville and its surrounding communities,” said Brian Davis, President of the Critical Illness Recovery Hospital Division at Select Medical.

The new “hospital within a hospital” is expected to improve care and be convenient to patients referred by health care providers throughout north-central Florida. The hospital moves into space vacated by UF Health’s heart vascular and neuro medicine departments.

“As the volume grows at UF Health Shands Hospital and the complexity of care increases, there’s a greater demand for post-acute services like those offered by Select Medical,” said UF Health Shands CEO Ed Jimenez. “This hospital-in-a-hospital model provides patients a more seamless transition of care.”

The staff at Select Specialty Hospital – Gainesville have also relocated and its medical team will be a mix of physicians from the surrounding community and the University of Florida College of Medicine.
