MECHANICSBURG, PA and BIRMINGHAM, AL, October 20, 2021 -- Select Medical and Grandview Medical Center, a subsidiary of Community Health Systems, announced today that they are forming a joint venture partnership called Champion Sports Medicine Birmingham, LLC, which will provide outpatient rehabilitation services. As part of the joint venture, Select Medical contributed five existing physical therapy centers that will now serve as Grandview Medical Center's affiliated outpatient rehabilitation network serving patients in Birmingham and surrounding communities. The centers will carry both the Champion Sports Medicine and Grandview Health brands. Select Medical will serve as the majority owner and operator of the joint venture.

"Together, we recognized a significant market need for best-in-class physical therapy in Birmingham. Under the partnership, two Champion Sports Medicine centers will reside in Birmingham with additional locations in Gardendale, Hueytown and Vestavia Hills.

"Our goals include continuing to expand services and the quality of healthcare provided by our teams. This partnership aligns with our core belief of making healthcare more accessible to the patients and communities we serve."
