Skinner will direct the entire Dallas/Fort Worth market, which encompasses four rehabilitation hospitals, more than 50 outpatient therapy clinics and Baylor Rehab Home Health Services. In addition, Skinner will oversee the management of two inpatient rehabilitation units and acute therapy services at nine Baylor Scott & White Health hospitals.

Brehm, president of the Inpatient Rehabilitation Hospital Division for Select Medical. “We are fortunate to promote someone who has been part of the Baylor family for over 20 years.
